



AGF LIFETIME MEMBERSHIP NOMINATION FORM



The AGF Lifetime Membership is a special award which honours and recognizes individuals who have provided long-term service to the Alberta Gymnastics Federation. Nominees eligible for consideration shall be presented to the Board of Directors and may be selected for recognition at the awards banquet.

Guidelines for submission of nominations for AGF Lifetime Membership:

- All applications and any supporting materials must be submitted by **Friday, July 27, 2018 at 4:00pm**.
- Individuals must be in good standing with AGF and have been involved with AGF in some capacity for a minimum of 15 years.
- At the end of this document is a sample that can be used as a reference on how to complete the form.
- Please note that should your submission be successful you will be required to submit a minimum of five (5) good quality photos of the nominee and/or video to add to the presentation at the AGF Awards Gala.

The Nomination Form is in three parts:

- **Part 1** provides a brief overview of the nominee's contribution to the Alberta Gymnastics Federation in **Years of Service** (min. of 15 years) and should outline the **Levels of Involvement** using one or two sentences – i.e. International, National, Provincial and Club.
- **Part 2** describes the specific nature of the nominee's involvement through a **Variety of Roles**, as well as the overall impact the nominee has had on the gymnastics community. If you are able to outline the areas and estimate the number of people who have benefited from the nominee's contribution, please do so in the space provided – i.e. types of roles listed in form below.
- **Part 3** provides other supporting details of the nominee's contribution. This includes **Outstanding Achievements** and **Special Initiatives and/or Program Development** – i.e. other awards received, international results, a list of publications/manuals written and special program contributions.
