

NCCP EVALUATION CHALLENGE: SENIOR NATIONAL TEAM ATHLETE

Gymnastics Canada provides an opportunity for current and retired Canadian Senior National Team Athletes to *challenge* our National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) evaluations. Instead of taking the required NCCP courses and then completing a coaching evaluation, applicants can be approved to proceed directly to the evaluation.

To be considered for recognition of coaching competence through Gymnastics Canada, applicants must be aged 19 or older, a previously carded member of a Gymnastics Canada Senior National Team, as well as a registered coach with their provincial/territorial gymnastics federation (PTO).

Once their application has been reviewed, the applicant and their club will receive written notification from Gymnastics Canada confirming the level of evaluation that they are able to challenge. This will be completed on a case-by-case basis; some consideration may be given to special cases.

The applicant may be approved to challenge either the Gymnastics Foundations Evaluation OR the Competition 1 Evaluation, depending on the level of athletes they are currently coaching.

The applicant will receive an evaluation package after the level of evaluation has been determined. Upon its completion, Gymnastics Canada will assign an NCCP Trained Coach Evaluator to the applicant.

COACHING APPLICATION DOSSIER

Those applying to the NCCP Evaluation Challenge must submit the following to Gymnastics Canada:

- ✓ Non-refundable \$125.00 application fee Payable to Gymnastics Canada
- ✓ Vulnerable Sector Check or Enhanced Police Information Check issued within the last year
- ✓ Covering letter from the applicant
- ✓ Covering letter from the applicant's current club they are coaching at
- ✓ Up-to-date resumé which must include (1) Name (2) Date of Birth (3) NCCP # (4) Brief outline of National Team involvement (e.g., dates, profile) (5) Educational background (6) Description of coaching experience (7) List of NCCP courses completed (if applicable) (8) Other related information

For their application to be considered, applicants must also complete the following training:

- ✓ <u>NCCP Making Ethical Decisions (MED) Online Evaluation</u>
- ✓ <u>NCCP Emergency Action Plan</u>
- ✓ <u>NCCP Making Head Way</u>
- ✓ <u>Safe Sport Training</u>
- ✓ <u>Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders</u>

As part of their coaching application dossier, Gymnastics Canada recommends that applicants complete the Gymnastics Foundations Theory Course through their PTO. This course is comprised of two modules: Planning a Practice and Making Ethical Decisions. Upon completion, applicants will be able to access the MED Online Evaluation at no cost and have unlimited attempts to pass the evaluation.

HERE'S HOW TO APPLY

Please submit the application form on page 2 (to <u>coaching@gymcan.org</u>) with all the required documentation. A minimum of 4 weeks is required to complete the application review process.

Once the application is approved by Gymnastics Canada, we will contact the applicant to confirm the level of evaluation that they are able to challenge. A minimum of 4 weeks is then required to complete the evaluation process.
