4.2. Motions Made by Clubs/WPC

MOTION by WPC: To allow the following: For qualification purposes only, if, after the completion of the last event, an athlete's AA score in a 0.1 or less than the minimum qualification score, the coach may submit an inquiry for the gymnast's lowest scoring event (regardless of the order in which that event was performed). This only applies to a level that cannot fill all allotted team spots. Judges could decide to voluntarily watch the video of the routine in question.

MOTION by WPC: To not allow HP athletes to attend Westerns in a team or wildcard position.

4.3. Handbook Approval

- Updates as per Spring 2026 WPA
 - An athlete not named to the GymCan High-Performance list can compete at Provincials in a High-Performance category but would not be eligible for awards or Alberta ranking points.

- That a Team Coach may only be assigned as the Team Coach for one team at Westerns and Nationals. Exception: For Westerns, if the Level 8 team is not participating in podium training, a coach may be assigned as the Team Coach for both the Level 8 team and either the Level 9 or Level 10 team, provided there are no scheduling conflicts.
 - If a coach is already assigned as a team coach and another coach from that club cannot attend in the other team coach position, that coach/club and the technical director would decide on the next team coach
