#### 4.1. Review Meet #1

##### 4.1.1. Mobilizing Twice in a Meet

Tourism Calgary had some funds we could use towards events so looking into hosting Canadians.

Provincials – In person likely not happening in the next 3-5 months.

BC has been doing cups and looking for a virtual provincials, could ask them about how they are running it.

Provincials should occur this year at least, whether virtual or in person.

Clubs are still willing to attend if virtual.

Could do virtual and if things do open up we could do our own in person event afterwards to just have everyone together again.

Timing – First week of June virtually?

May 31 – June 7 judging on the 13<sup>th</sup> but TBD for judging.

That gives 10 weeks to prepare, should be enough time.

Survey on if clubs would participate. Give feedback if they don't work.

**ACTION: K. Quon to reach out to the missing clubs to have a decision by the end of the week.**

Clubs can submit their best routine or treat it like a competition.

No ToF for level 1-3

Any competition attire, not necessarily club attire.

Submissions will be similar to mobility meets.
