SUCCESSSES (RESULTS/EVENTS/RECOGNITION)

- 2nd AB Virtual Mobility technical trial a success

ISSUES FROM THE BOARD (FINANCIAL/PROGRAM/ETC.) –

- Safe Sport – N / A
- Communication surrounding restart and AGF will have round table next Wednesday (information has been circulated to clubs)
- Introduction of Social Media Campaign that will lead into Olympics – will have tools that clubs can use on their own social media (outline to be available asap)
- AGF is looking at producing a quarterly publication to ensure that all members are up to date with information.

OTHER

- GYM CAN –
 - Event Manager Position - Getting down to last few applicants
 - WC Italy a GO – Jeremy (QC) will compete (leaves May 30)
 - Elite Canada – “talking” about alternatives for Elite for locked down provinces – ONLY POSSIBLY
 - CoP has been released
 - Looking to get the Canadian Pathways document out earlier this year to clubs in early fall.
