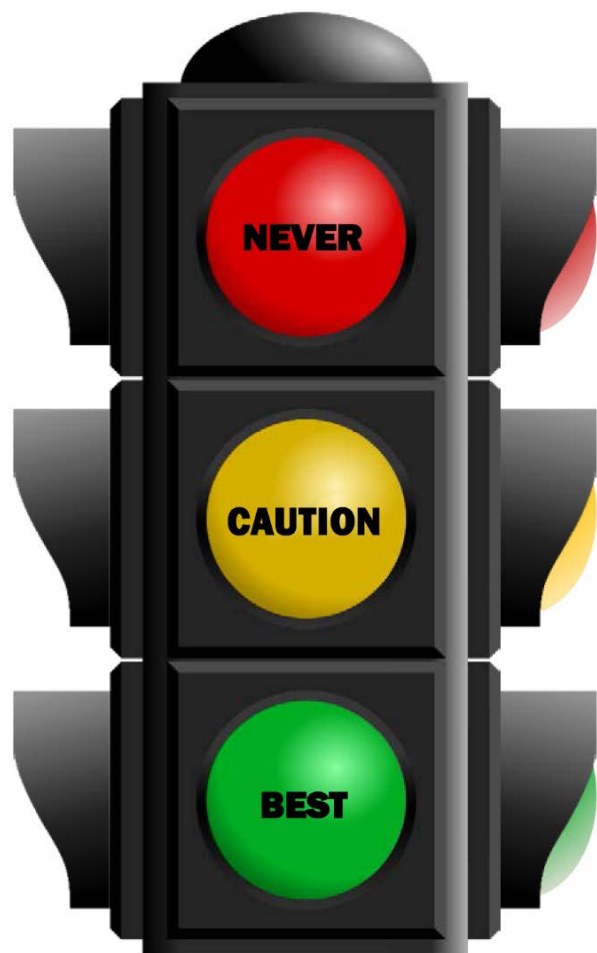


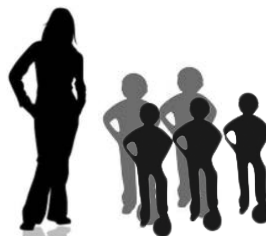
GUIDELINES FOR ADULT/ATHLETE INTERACTIONS

Purpose of guidelines:

To protect minor athletes and other Alberta Gymnastics Federation (AGF) members in potentially vulnerable situations by ensuring more than one adult is present.

GUIDELINES FOR ADULT/ATHLETE INTERACTIONS

What is an AGF Certified Adult?

An AGF Certified Adult is 18 years of age or older with the following requirements met:

Respect in Sport (Activity Leaders) Course ¹	Required	Recommended
Completion of the National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP) Making Ethical Decisions Online Evaluation	Required	N/A
Certification in the Respect in Sport (Workplace) Course	Recommended	N/A
Certification in the Respect in Sport (Parents) Course	N/A	Required ²

¹ Must be current as per AGF Policies and Procedures

² Exceptions only apply to coaches who have completed the Respect in Sport (Activity Leaders) Course
