DO YOU HAVE WHAT IT TAKES TO BE A COMPETITION 1 LEARNING FACILITATOR?

Here are the requirements for NCCP Gymnastics Foundations Learning Facilitator training:

- must be registered member of Alberta Gymnastics Federation
- must be a minimum of 21 years of age
- must have a minimum of five (5) years' experience coaching gymnastics
- must be **certified Comp 2** (or equivalent) in the appropriate gymnastics discipline
- must be a proven clinician and an outgoing, enthusiastic leader
- must have outstanding interpersonal and communication skills
- must have demonstrated commitment and adherence to the NCCP philosophy and content
- must be willing to devote time to facilitating NCCP courses throughout the province and to fulfilling all administrative tasks associated with course delivery
- a degree in physical education or a related discipline is an asset

THE FORMAT FOR LF TRAINING IS AS FOLLOWS:

1. LF in-training must complete the CAC LF core training module.
2. LF in-training must attend the entire Competition 1 LF training course and successfully meet all course requirements.
3. Following the course, the LF-in-training must complete at least one co-delivery, ideally with a Master Coach Developer or experienced LF.
4. Once the LF-in-training has completed their co-delivery, he/she is a trained LF and can give courses on his/her own.

Please complete and submit the attached registration form to Alberta Gymnastics Federation (education@abgym.ab.ca) by May 26, 2019. **All** required documentation must accompany your registration.

- The deadline for applications is May 26, 2019.
- Final selection of applicants will be done by Alberta Gymnastics. Applicants who are not selected will be notified in writing.
- Applicants who are selected will be notified by email.

Your application package for LF training must include the following:

- This application form
- Resumé
- Copy of current Police Record and Vulnerable sector check (must be current within last 3 years)
- Copy of your NCCP transcripts
